Basic website setup

Registrar

The company that you register your domain with eg mywebsitename.com.au

Delegation

Your host will suppliy you with "Delegation codes" that allows you to point your domain to your host. When you login to your registrars website, there will be somewhere to add your "delegation codes". The codes will typically look like this:

ns1.myhostcompany.com.au ns2.myhostcompany.com.au ns3.myhostcompany.com.au ns4.myhostcompany.com.au

After 1-48 hours of adding these codes, your *domain* will now point to your *host*.
